Matthew 5.3

³ Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Poor in Spirit

- What "poor in spirit" means according to Matthew 5.3
- What "poor in spirit" does not mean.

Poor in Spirit Illustrated - Psalm 51.1-17; 2 Sam 11-12

- David a man after God's own heart? Really?
- The poor in spirit recognize they can bring nothing to God, but instead... v.1-6
 - Acknowledge their sin v.1–2
 - Own their sin v.3
 - Feel their sin v.4a
 - Agree with God about their sin v.4b
 - Are not surprised or scandalized by their sin v.5–6
- The poor in spirit depend wholly on the grace of God... v.7-12
 - To make them clean v.7
 - To restore a fresh sense of God's presence to them v.8-9, 11
 - To shape their hearts into conformity with His v.10, 12
- The poor in spirit make the best missionaries v.13-17
 - They see others rightly v.13
 - They have something to sing about and talk about v.14–15
 - They have a message of freedom v.16
 - They have a message of hope v.17
